Recently Sportscapes Construction installed 100,000 square feet of Sporturf™ MT50 for Waverly High School in Ohio. The crew removed the tired natural grass surface and replaced it with a layered stone base which included a brand new concrete curb on the inside of the track surface. Once the stone base and curb were in place it was time for Sporturf™ MT50 to be installed. MT50 is a combination of the high performance monofilament face yarn and a texturized thatch that traps and minimizes infill movement. Dan Hodson of Sportscapes Construction stated, "They (Waverly) really enjoyed the look and feel of the monofilament fiber and thatch layer from the beginning."
